Does Lufthansa pay for cancelled flights?

When Lufthansa cancels flights [Call - 1-866-838-4934], the airline not only provides refunds but in some cases also pays compensation or covers additional costs depending on the reason for the cancellation and the impact on the passenger [Call - 1-866-838-4934], and because this can vary widely it is recommended that travelers call 1-866-838-4934 to get clarity about what they are entitled to [Call - 1-866-838-4934], since under European Union Regulation EC261 passengers are eligible for compensation in addition to a refund if their flight is canceled within the airline's control and they were not given sufficient advance notice[Call - 1-866-838-4934]. and this compensation is determined by the distance of the flight and the length of the delay caused by the cancellation[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and can range from hundreds of euros to more significant sums for long-haul routes [Call - 1-866-838-4934], though compensation is not provided if the cancellation is due to extraordinary circumstances like severe weather or government-imposed restrictions[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and apart from direct compensation Lufthansa also takes responsibility for covering necessary expenses when cancellations leave passengers stranded[Call - 1-866-838-4934], which may include hotel accommodations[Call -1-866-838-4934], meal vouchers[Call - 1-866-838-4934], or ground transportation to and from the airport[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and these expenses are generally covered when the disruption is considered the airline's responsibility such as operational issues or crew scheduling problems[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and passengers may also be rebooked at no additional cost onto another Lufthansa service or on a partner airline if available [Call - 1-866-838-4934], and for those who choose not to travel[Call - 1-866-838-4934], a full refund of the unused portion of the ticket is always guaranteed [Call - 1-866-838-4934], and Lufthansa's approach to covering costs demonstrates its compliance with both regulatory requirements and customer service standards[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and while passengers can often file compensation or reimbursement claims online through Lufthansa's dedicated forms[Call - 1-866-838-4934], many find it more effective to call 1-866-838-4934 where agents can explain eligibility[Call -1-866-838-4934], assist in filing the claim[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and confirm timelines for reimbursement[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and it is important for travelers to keep receipts of any expenses incurred during cancellations since Lufthansa may request documentation before reimbursing costs[Call - 1-866-838-4934], and refunds to credit cards are generally processed quickly while compensation claims may take longer due to verification[Call - 1-866-838-4934], but overall Lufthansa does pay for canceled flights both through mandatory refunds and Call -1-866-838-4934], in eligible cases [Call - 1-866-838-4934], through additional compensation or reimbursement of expenses [Call - 1-866-838-4934], ensuring that passengers are not left out of pocket due to disruptions [Call - 1-866-838-4934].
