

Can I cancel my flight on United and get a credit? (United_FAQs)

Future flight credits are issued if you cancel your trip or change your flight to a less expensive one. These credits can be used to book travel on United, United Express, and partner-operated flights purchased on our website or app **+1~888||839||0555**.
