

How the 24 Hour Rule Works with British Airways

British Airways provides passengers with the benefit of a 24 hour cancellation rule that acts as a safeguard for those who need to make changes right after booking[Call - 1-855-838-4886]. According to this policy[Call - 1-855-838-4886], when a flight is purchased at least seven days before the scheduled departure[Call - 1-855-838-4886], the traveler has the option to cancel the reservation within twenty-four hours and receive a full refund[Call - 1-855-838-4886]. This refund applies regardless of the fare type[Call - 1-855-838-4886], including tickets usually sold under restrictive conditions[Call - 1-855-838-4886].
