

UTILITIES SUPERINTENDENT

Due to retirement, the City of Lake View is seeking candidates for the position of Utilities Superintendent. Lake View is a community of 1,142 and is the home of Black Hawk Lake. Around 250,000 people visit Lake View annually. Residents enjoy a high quality of life with extraordinary outdoor recreation opportunities including hunting, fishing, camping, and boating. Lake View is the north end of the 33-mile long Sauk Rail Trail.

The Utilities Superintendent manages operations of the Electric and Public Works Departments. The Electric system has 1,400 meters and the water & sewer systems serve around 900 meters. Lake View's electric system includes services to our urban area, all of which are underground. It also includes 90 miles of rural line, most of which is aerial. The water treatment plant is iron and nitrate removal with aeration. The wastewater is a newly constructed aerated lagoon system with a SAGR and UV disinfection.

Preferred training is (1) certification as a Journeyman Lineman, and/or (2) Level 2 Certification from the State of Iowa in water treatment, water distribution, and wastewater treatment. Requires at least four years of work experience relating to electric and/or public works, at least one year of which was served in a supervisory position. Salary negotiable. Full benefits including health insurance, vacation, sick, and personal leave.
