Lake View Municipal Building

The Lake View City Council met in special session on Monday, January 10, 2022 at the Lake View Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order by Mayor John Westergaard at 7:03 p.m. Roll call was taken: Present: Councilors Dale Boeckman, Mike Frank, Tami Moeller, Ken Steinkamp, and Dave Woltman. Also present: Fire Chief Jim Garrels.

City Council Goal Setting / Planning Session

Fire Chief Jim Garrels spoke with the Council about purchasing a fire hydrant flow tester and assuring that the fire hydrants work properly. Chief Garrels will work the Utilities Superintendent to define which model of flow tester will be purchased.

The Mayor and City Council participated in a Goal Setting / Planning activity. The Mayor and each Council member had completed a questionnaire ranking potential community projects and initiatives. The Council reviewed the results.

Other items discussed:

- Housing: The Council discussed how the City may participate with different Developers in an equitable manner.
- Potential Camp Crescent projects / drainage.
- Brush Pile Site. The Council will work on a policy on the maintenance of the brush pile site and whether the site will be periodically burned.
- Property taxes: The Council reviewed data regarding taxable valuations and the amount of tax funds generated.

No action was taken on these issues.
