Lake View Municipal Building

The Lake View City Council met in special session on Monday, January 27, 2020 at the Lake View Municipal Building. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Pro-Tem Ken Steinkamp at 7:00 p.m. Roll call was taken: Present: Councilors Tami Moeller, Terry Reis, and Dave Woltman. Councilor Vickie Toms participated via videoconference. Absent: Mayor John Westergaard.

FY 2020-21 Budget

The Council reviewed a draft of the proposed FY 2020-21 budget. Total revenues are estimated to be \$5.9 million and total expenses are estimated to be \$6.2 million. Large projects included in this budget are: \$175,000 for a Camp Crescent Improvement Project, \$124,000 for a dump truck, \$200,000 for a street project, \$300,000 in Sponsored Project funds for the fish barrier, \$200,000 for the Library addition project, and \$115,000 in grant funding for the CDBG Housing Rehab program.

Motion by Woltman, second by Moeller, to set the maximum total tax property rate for FY 2020-21 at \$8.45 / \$1,000 of taxable valuation. Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Moeller, second by Steinkamp, to approve **Resolution # 20-10:** öResolution Scheduling Public Hearing on the FY 2020-21 Maximum Property Tax Dollars.ö Roll call vote: All ayes. Motion carried. The public hearing will be held on February 17<sup>th</sup>.

Motion by Woltman, second by Reis, to adjourn. On vote: all ayes. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:01 p.m.
