What is the pet fee on American? (Pet\_Policy)

[ \*\*\*++1-(888)-738-(0834) \*\*\* ] The agent will check if there is space for your pet in the cabin since only a limited number of pets are allowed per flight. [ \*\*\*\*++1-(888)-738-(0834) \*\*\* ] You'll also need to pay the pet fee, which is \$150 one way per kennel for tickets bought after February 20, 2024.
